

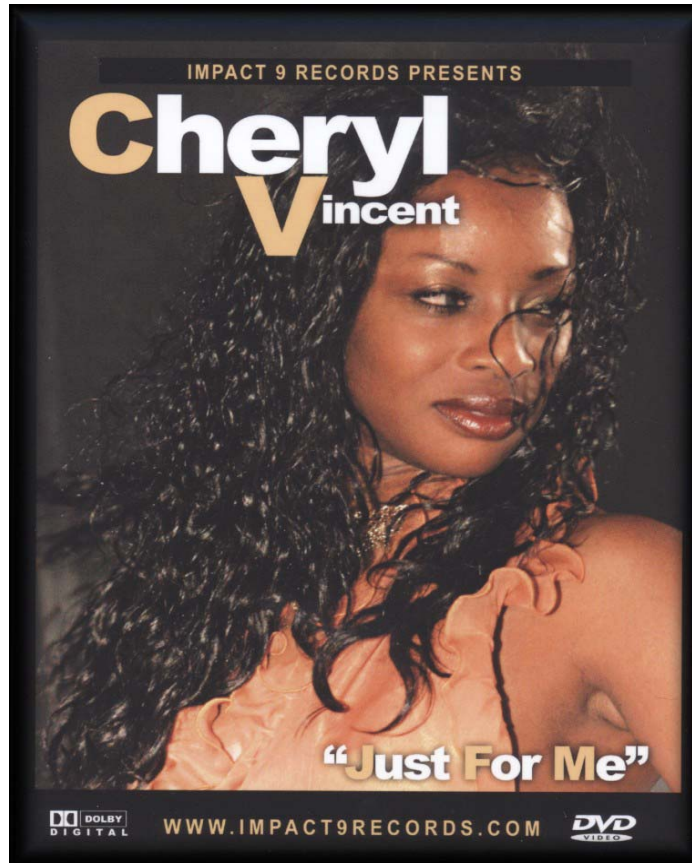

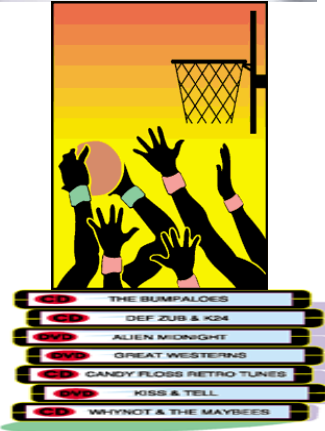

Web sites let users trade music, DVDs and games



New Web sites with names like Peerflix, BarterBee, Title Trade, and Lala are aiming to give your music a new lease on life by letting you trade it for different CDs, DVDs, movies, or games.



Instead of receiving cash in exchange for a movie, DVD, or game, members of the new sites collect points that can be used to buy other CDs or other media such as digital video disks from fellow members.

Lala, the newest site, only lists CDs for now, while Peerflix focuses on DVDs. Other sites, like BarterBee and TitleTrader LLC, let people swap between categories, a movie for a video game, for example.

After signing on, you can create a list of used products that you are willing to sell. If another member asks to buy something on your list, the site will notify you by email. Once you agree to a sale, you have a few days to put the item in the mail.

Because many people have a whole cabinet full of music and movies they seldom use now, these sites could create a fine opportunity to trade their classical music for country, for example, or vice versa.



Get fit! Walk two miles, that's all you have to do

It seems complicated. To get fit, will you buy exercise videos and try to do what a 20-year-old athlete does? Or buy some exercise machines? Or sign up for a health club and hope to get your money's worth?



Actually, you don't have to do anything heroic. You can do anything that keeps you active for half an hour on most days, anything from working in the yard to playing basketball. Easiest of all:

just walk two miles. No fuss, no equipment, no membership, just walk. The best distance is two miles.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and the National Institutes of Health say this regular exercise does wonders. It protects your heart, reduces the risk of diabetes (or helps control it), reduces high blood pressure, and helps to prevent osteoporosis.

The walk will give you increased energy, help to prevent weight gain (or reverse it), and help you sleep better. And it will make you

look younger, feel younger, and live longer.

Can't walk two miles? Just walk a few blocks to start with, then gradually increase the distance.

Check with your doctor if you have been really inactive for a long period of time. Get advice on how to start, then do.

Cybercrooks target more individuals

A big increase in phishing scams is under way. Security experts say crooks are more often targeting individuals now instead of big companies.

Phishing scams are

phony emails designed to trick consumers into revealing personal data such as Social Security numbers. Operators send thousands of random emails that appear to come from eBay, Citibank, and others.

The scams may target people in the same region who use the same bank or credit union, according to Symantec, the software security company, and the Anti-Phishing Working Group. Symantec says it detected an average of 7.9 million daily phishing attempts in the last half of 2005, up 39 percent from the previous half.

Many phishing scams ask people to update their account or claim that an account is being cancelled.

Never click on a link contained in an email. Open a new window in your browser and type in the address. If an email appears to come from your bank or credit union, call the institution to see if they are trying to contact you.

Never give your password or social security number on a Web form, especially if you are urged to do so in an email.

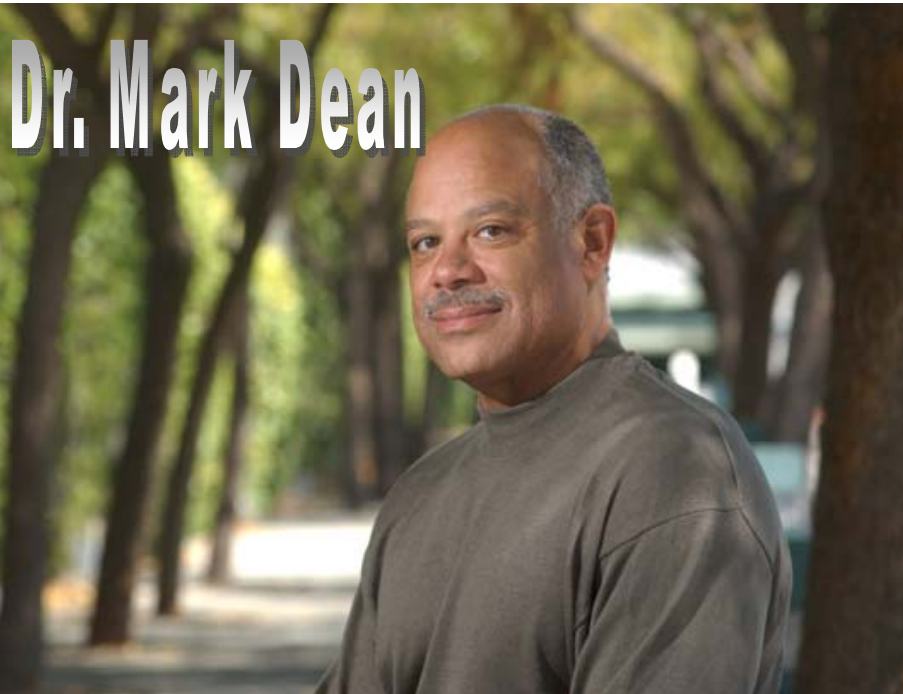

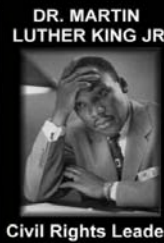
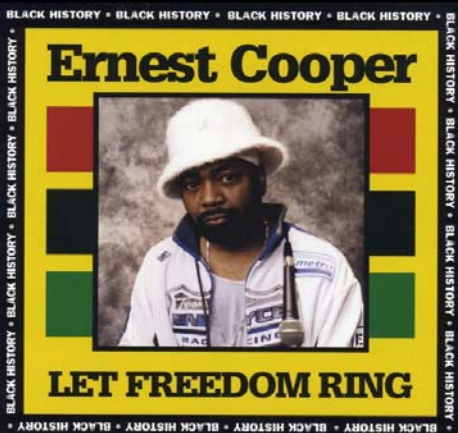
